Executive Summary

The 2016-17 interview cycle began with a pilot of 29 individual interviews at one 14(c) certified employer site. UW-Whitewater interviewers worked with the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation (DVR) to transition to group interviews as the default option based upon feedback from the pilot and initial interviews. This provided more comfort and peer support during interviews for the majority of those interviewed, while ensuring that all interviews were completed within the allowable timeframe.

The cycle included 6,509 interviews of subminimum wage employees from 75 14(c) certified employers in more than 100 unique locations across Wisconsin. Only seven (7) subminimum wage employees refused the interview when offered by the UW-Whitewater employee.

The majority of those interviewed were: male (58%), had a guardian (65%), and 25-64 years old (84%), with 7% under 25 years old and 9% over 65 years old. Interviews primarily occurred in groups (88.7%) of up to five (5) subminimum wage employees. The majority (57%) did not include any additional guests. The northeastern areas of the state (Workforce Development Areas 4 and 5) had the most subminimum wage employee's interviewed.

The following data is based entirely on self-report of subminimum wage employees. Their responses may not be completely accurate or reliable.

A small percentage (9.5%) of the respondents report a current community job, however nearly one-third reported interest in working in the community (32.1%) and another 12% would consider it. Respondents had limited experience with post-secondary education and those who did primarily received it at their 14c site. Most had no experience with DVR (43%), although there appears to be a trend toward recent engagement with DVR services. Respondents have not experienced any classes or training on self-advocacy or self-determination skills (71%), but the majority provided examples demonstrating their self-advocacy (56%) and self-determination (53%) skills during their interviews.

The following pages include infographics of the key content areas required by the UW-Whitewater contract with DVR (see Index p.3). UW-Whitewater's professional interviewers engaged in semi-structured discussions, with both closed and open-ended questions, along with follow up and clarifying questions based upon provided responses and comprehension. Interviewers adapt their style of questioning and flow of discussion based upon the communication styles and topics of interest among those interviewed to best engage the individual or group and elicit their responses.


The following questions are listed in general categories and are not scripted questions asked of each worker. For example, Q4.5 represents interviewers asking a range of questions such as what the person is good at doing, what they like to do, what they are learning at their 14c site, etc. rather than asking "what are your prevocational/pre-employment skills." Likewise, the responses are categorized by the interviewers and are not quotes from those interviewed.






Q2.5 - Does the worker have a guardian?





This category includes all who reported "completing" high school, inducing those who received a diploma, certificate of completion, or aged-out of school services




Q3.2 - What type of high school(s) did you attend? (Choose all that apply)


Q4.1 - Where are you living right now?






Q1.8 - Other(s) present for interview













Q4.3 - Able to provide examples of self-advocacy



Q4.4 - Able to provide examples of self-determination








