UWW Wireless: Connecting Laptop to Wireless as a Guest

OVERVIEW

This guide will walk you through the steps to connect your laptop device to the UWW wireless network as a guest device.

Note: Guest devices connecting to wireless will only stay active in the system for up to 12 hours. At that time the device must go through the guest wireless registration process again.

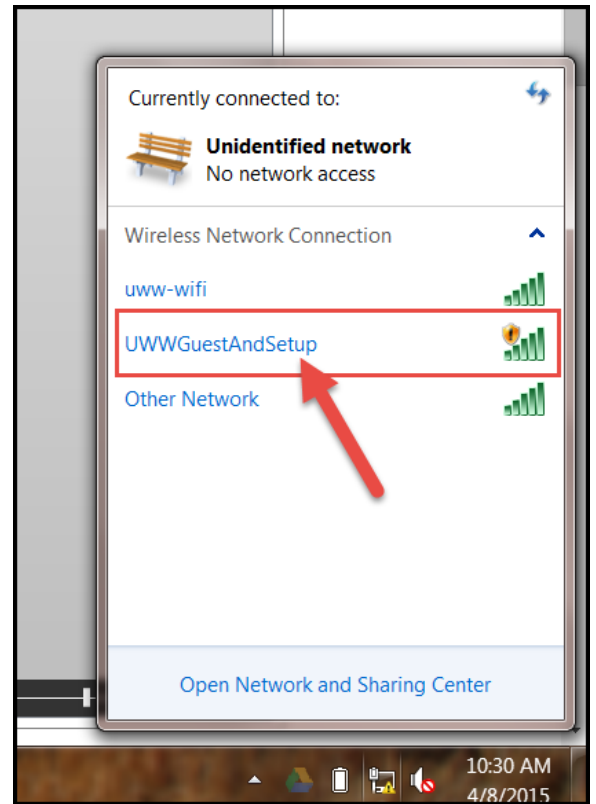


Step 1.

From your computer, locate your wireless connectivity icon.

Select “UWWGuestAndSetup” from the WI-FI menu options.

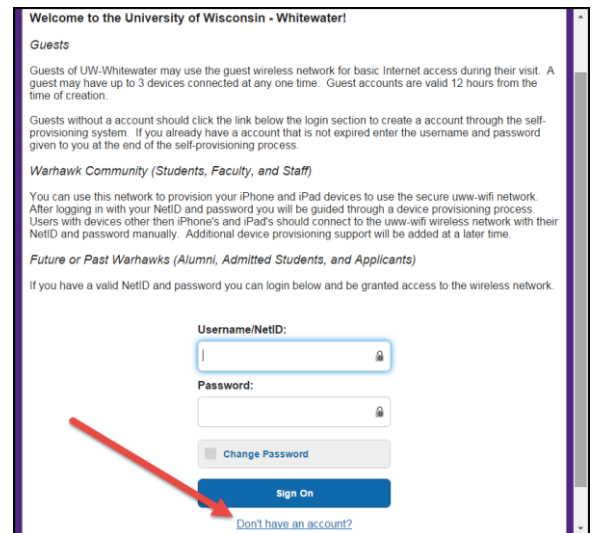
A web browser should now open automatically for you. If not, open a web browser to launch the UWW Wi-Fi registration page and browse to any non-uwv webpage, such as google.com or msn.com to be redirected to the UW-Whitewater wireless device registration page.



Step 2.

Guests: Please read through the information provided about guest accounts. Then scroll down to the bottom of the page to enter your guest wireless credentials.

GUEST NOTE: You can create a guest account by scrolling to the bottom of the page and clicking the “Don’t have account” link.




Step 3.

Enter your first name, last name and email address.
Tap the **Register** button to continue.


Step 4.

You will receive a page with your temporary wireless guest account information.

NOTE: Please write down this information as you will need it to complete the wireless registration below.

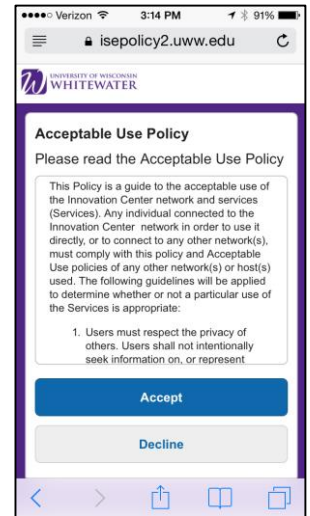

Step 5.

Tap the **Accept** button to continue.

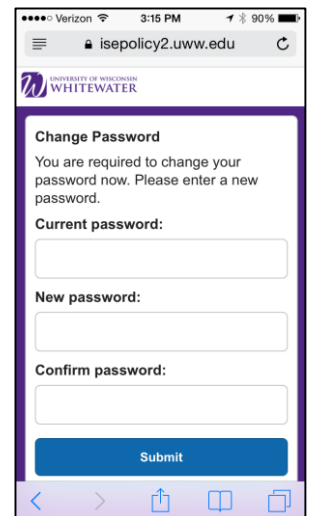
NOTE: Tap the **Not Now** button if prompted to save your password.



Step 6.

You will be prompted to change your temporary guest wireless password. Please enter the current temporary password, then your new password in the “New password” and “Confirm password” boxes available.

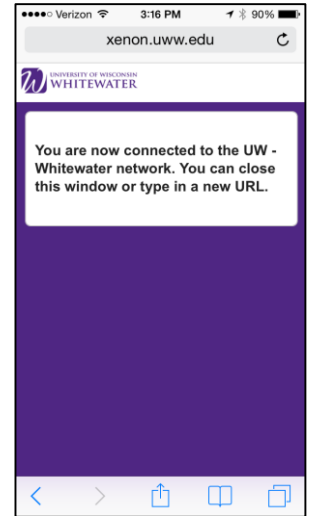
Tap **Submit** to continue.



Step 7.
