Net-ID

UW-Whitewater students are assigned a unique Net-ID. Your Net-ID functions as your username to access university resources.

Net-ID passwords expire every 180 days and you will receive email reminders to reset your password.

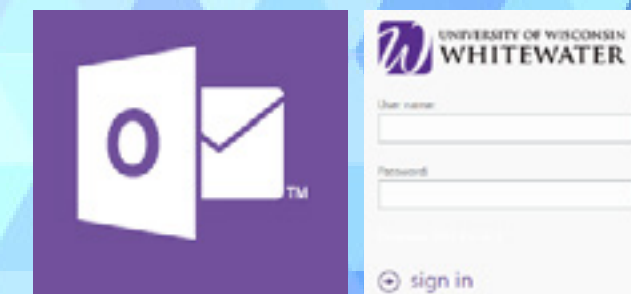

Student email accounts are automatically created when a student is accepted to UW-Whitewater. Students access email via Outlook Web Access (OWA) at post.uww.edu and receive 350MB of email storage.

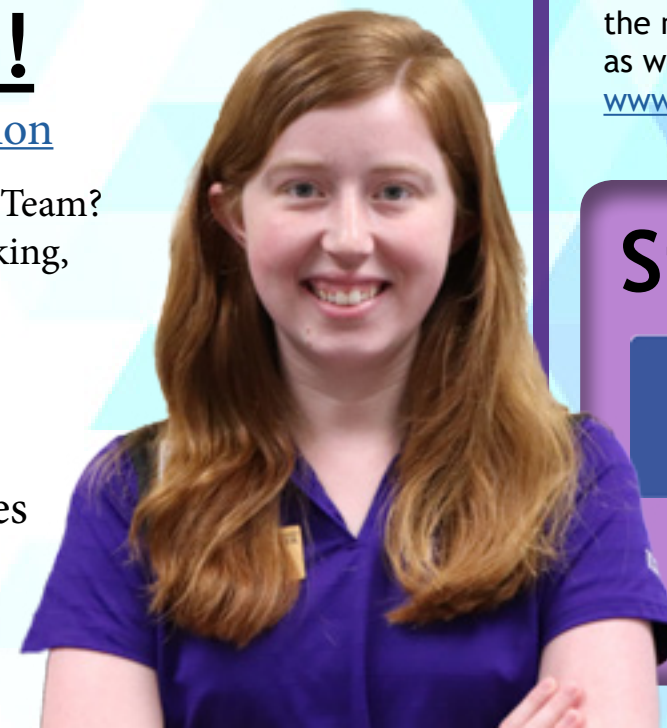
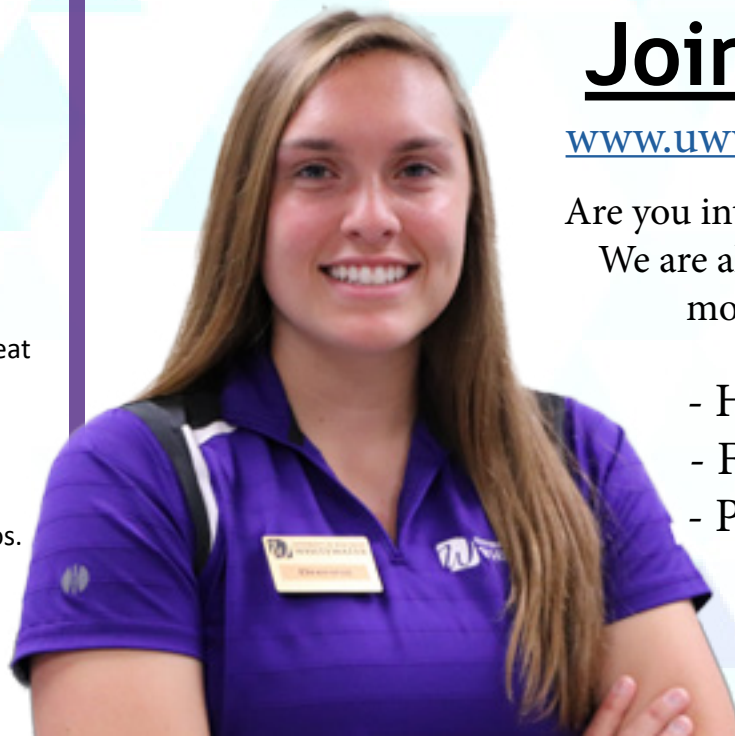
