Connect to Wi-Fi on a Chromebook

OVERVIEW

This guide will walk you through the steps to connect to the UW-Whitewater wireless network on campus with your Google Chromebook.

Step 1

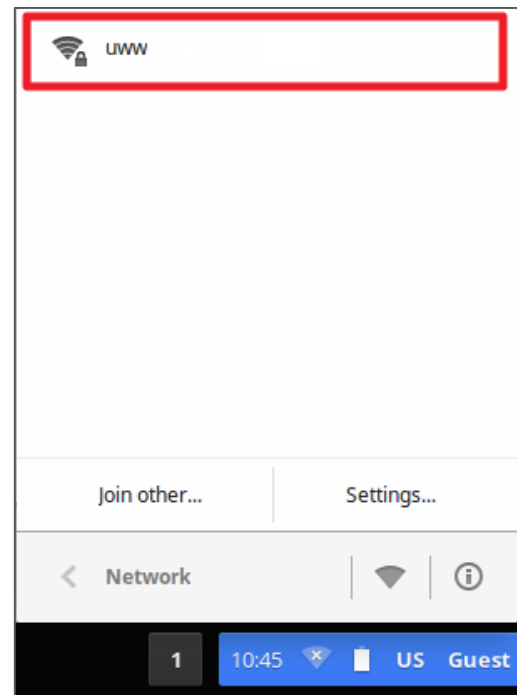
Right click on the Wi-Fi icon located in the bottom right-hand corner of your screen.

Step 2

Select "No Network", then "uww"

If you are prompted to enter a user name and password, please enter your Net-ID and password here.

You should now be connected to the UW-Whitewater wireless network. The white bars indicate signal strength.



Manually Connecting to Wireless

If you have trouble completing the steps above, please follow the steps below to configure the wireless connection manually.

Step 1

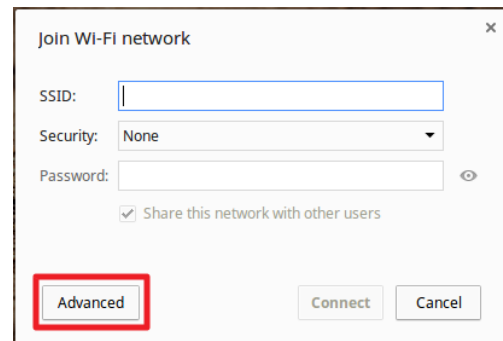
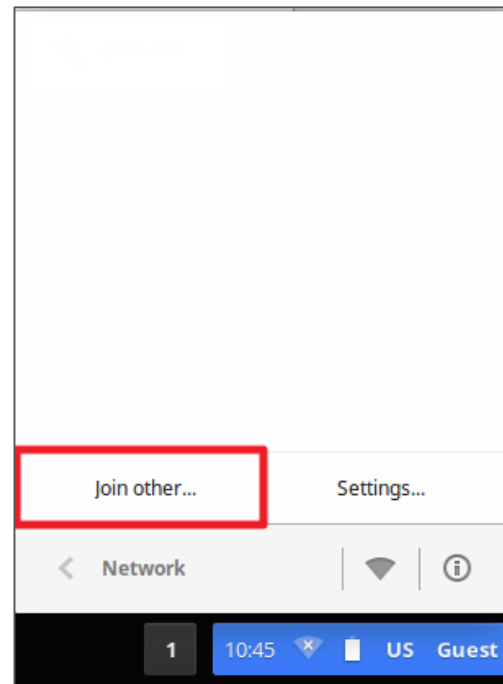
Right click on the Wi-Fi icon located in the bottom right-hand corner of your screen.

Step 2

Select "No Network", then "Join Other"

Step 3

Click the **Advanced** button.



Step 4


Set the following information in the available selection boxes:

- SSID: **uww**
- EAP Method: PEAP
- Phase 2 authentication: MSCHAPv2
- Identity: Your UW Net-ID
- Password: Your UW password

Check the “Save identity and password” box if you would like to save your Wi-Fi settings for future use. Do not save your identity if this is a public computer.

Click **Connect** to continue.

You should now be connected to the UW-Whitewater wireless network. The white bars indicate signal strength.
