Connect to Wi-Fi on an Android Device

OVERVIEW

This guide will walk you through the steps to connect to the UW-Whitewater wireless network on campus with your Android Device.

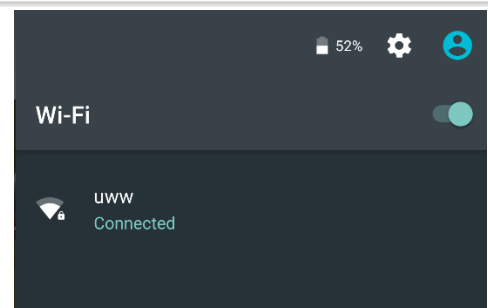
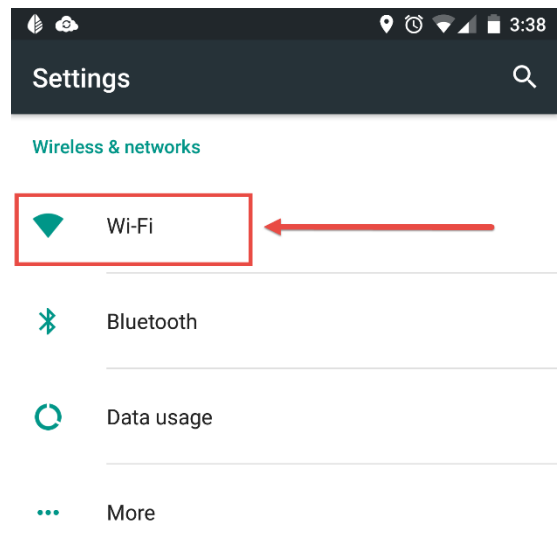
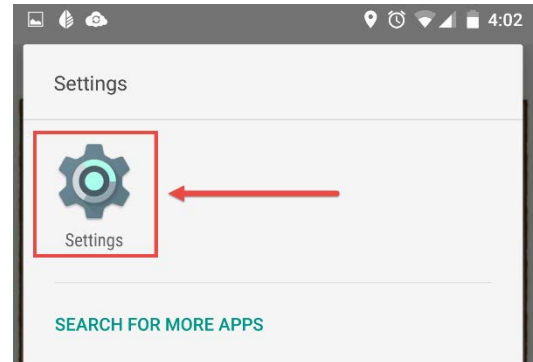
Step 1

Locate your phone's **Wi-Fi control** settings. Usually located at the top of your screen or under the **Settings** application.

Step 2

Make sure your Wi-Fi is turned on and select "**uww**" under the available networks

If you are prompted to enter a user name and password, please enter your Net-ID and password here.



You should now be connected to the UW-Whitewater wireless network. The white bars indicate signal strength.

Manually Connecting to Wireless

If you have trouble completing the steps above, please follow the steps below to configure the wireless connection manually.

Step 1

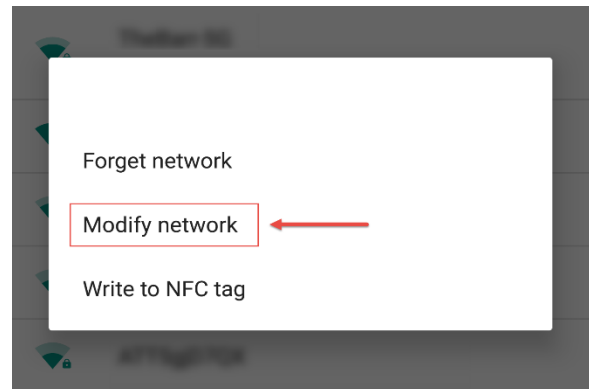
Under the available networks screen, tap and hold the “**uww**” network until vibrate. This should bring up a window with further options.

Step 2

Select “**Modify Network**”.

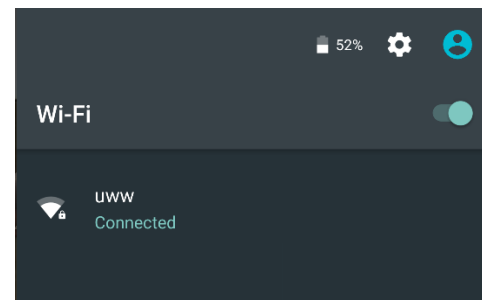
Set the following information in the available selection boxes:

- SSID: uww
- EAP Method: PEAP
- Phase 2 authentication: MSCHAPv2
- Identity: **Your UW Net-ID**
- Password: **Your UW password**



Step 3

You should now be connected to the UW-Whitewater wireless network. The white bars indicate signal strength.
