UWW Wireless: Registering Windows Laptop to UWW Wireless Network for Students.

OVERVIEW

This guide will walk you through the steps to register your Windows computer to the UWW network to allow you access to the UWW wireless network.

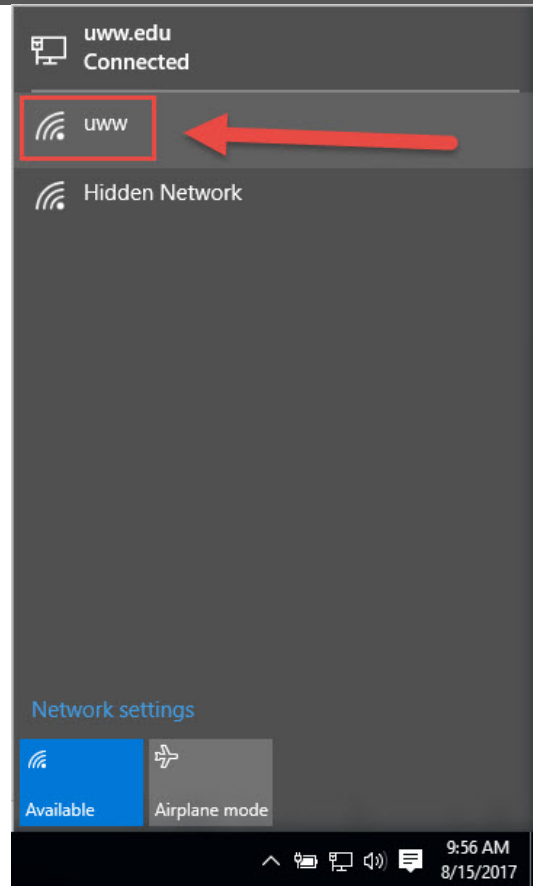
Note: Devices registered to the UWW wireless network will remain registered for 2 years. A total of 15 devices can be registered to the wireless network at one time for each user. You can manage your registered wireless devices by going to: <https://mydevices.uww.edu>



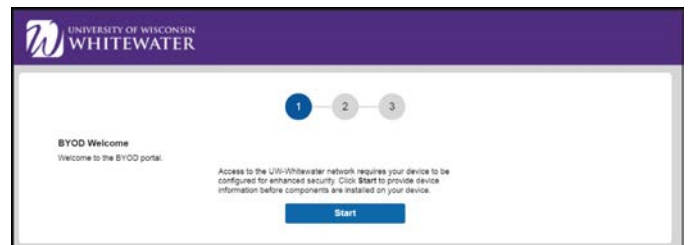
Registering Your Device

- Step 1.** Locate the wireless connectivity icon in the system tray.
- Step 2.** Select “uww” from the WI-FI menu options.

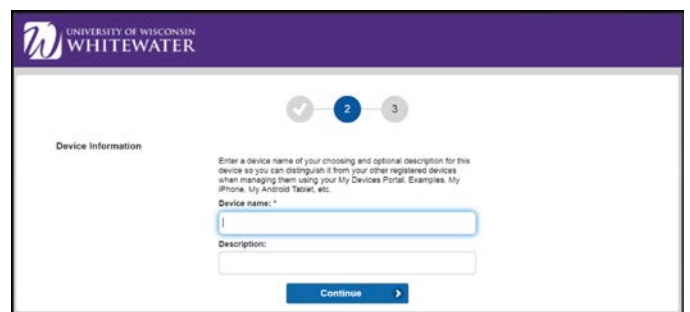
A web browser should now open automatically for you. If not, open a web browser to launch the UWW Wi-Fi registration page. If the UWW registration page does not load automatically, browse to a “non-secure site” such as the UWW homepage to be redirected to the UW-Whitewater wireless device registration page.



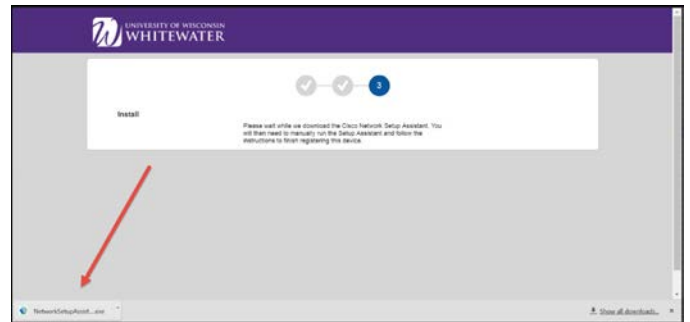
- Step 3.** Click the **Start** button to start the registration process.



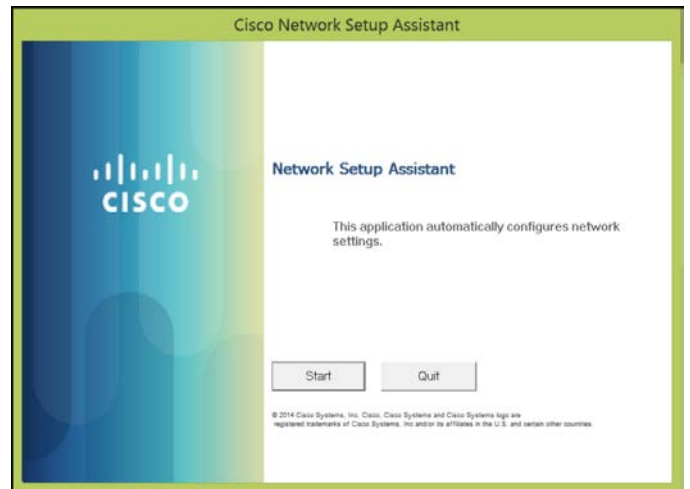
- Step 4.** Enter a name and description for your device, then click **Continue**.



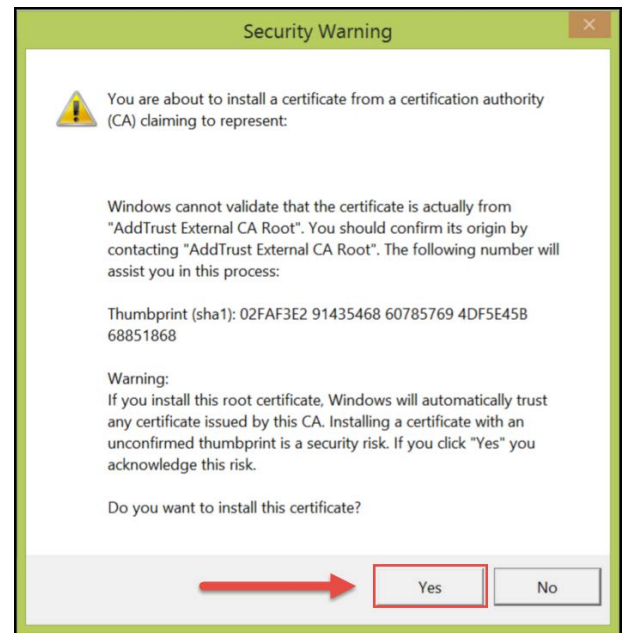
Step 5. The Cisco Network Setup Assistant installer should now download to your machine. Click the “NetworkSetupAssistant.exe” application to launch the installer.



Step 6. Click the **Start** button to launch the Network Setup Assistant installer.

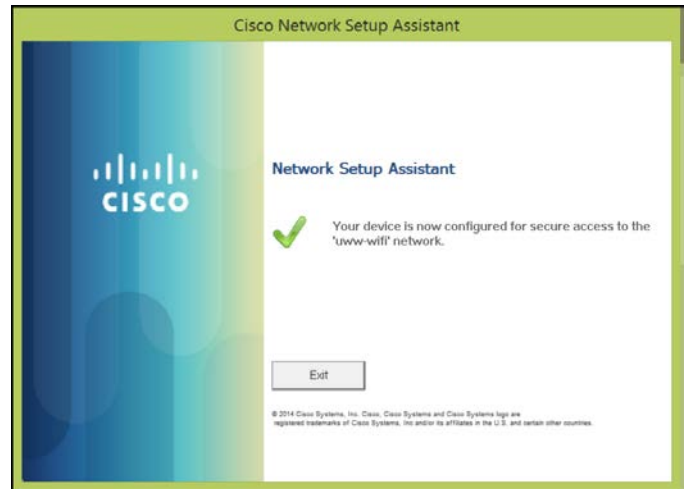


Step 7. Click the **Yes** button to accept the security certificate.

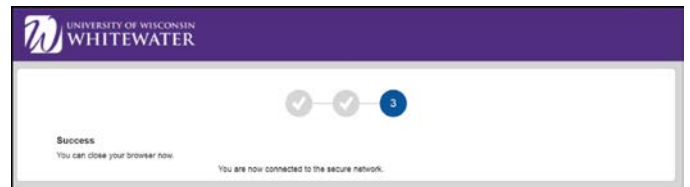


Your computer is now successfully registered to the UWW wireless network.

Step 8. Click the **Exit** button to continue.



Step 9. Once you see the “Success” page you are done and should now have Wireless.
