WHY STUDY ABROAD?

For an English major, studying abroad offers the opportunity to make the well-trodden pilgrimage to the birthplace of Shakespeare, discuss literature in a multinational classroom in continental Europe, or hone one's creative writing skills on a beach Down Under. Study abroad participants also develop cross-cultural communication, problem-solving, and language skills that are highly sought-after in many careers.

ACADEMICS

English majors considering studying abroad are advised to work with their academic advisor to identify the best time to study abroad, based on the student's degree requirements and the courses offered on the study abroad program of the student's choice.

Some English courses abroad may be evaluated as equivalent to particular UW-Whitewater courses. Additionally, many study abroad programs offer unique English coursework that may not be offered at UW-Whitewater and which may be used in the major with departmental approval.

In addition to satisfying major requirements, students may also fulfil minor, foreign language, or breadth requirements abroad.
