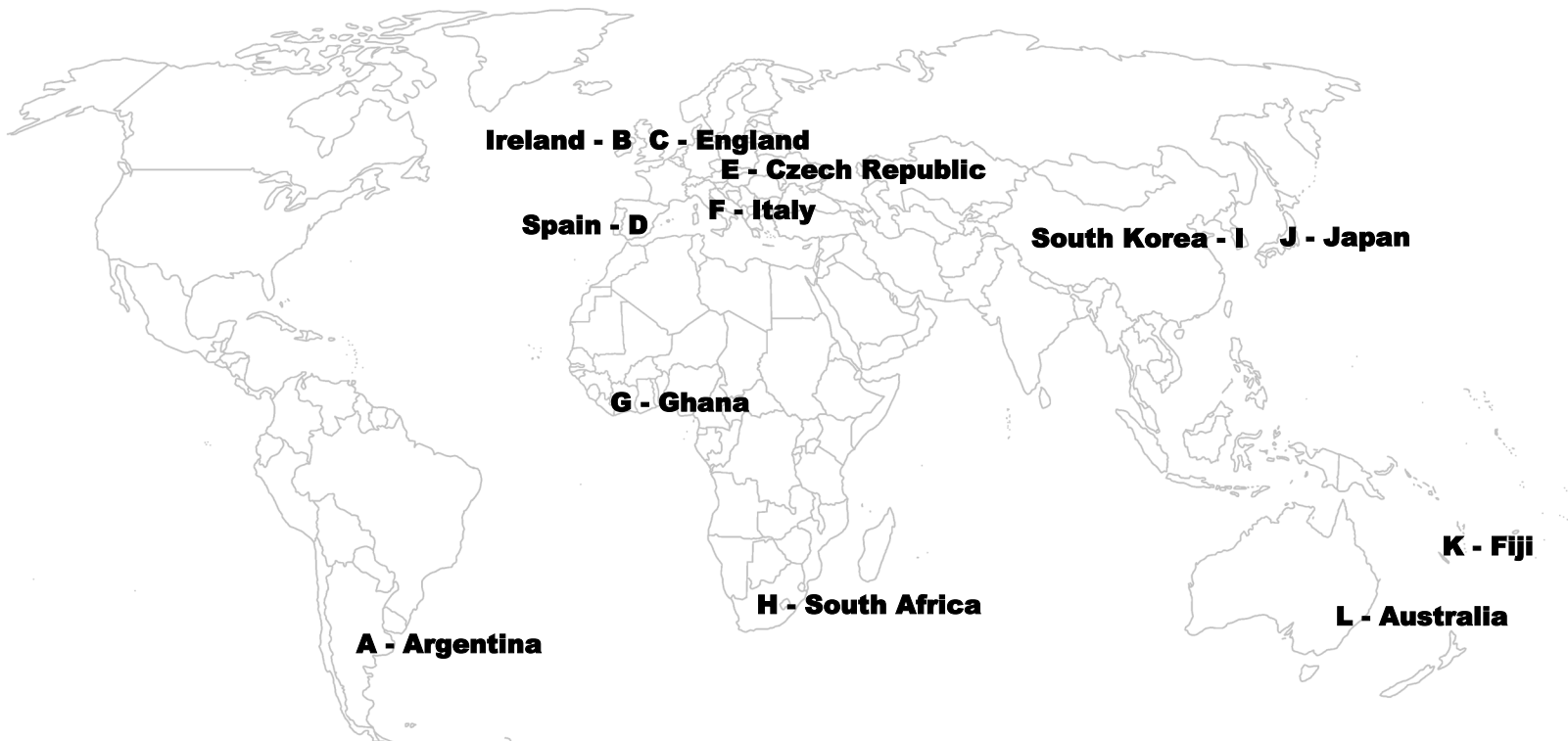

WHY STUDY ABROAD?

The study of history allows students to gain an understanding of human society as it has existed across time and place. Studying abroad gives history majors a unique opportunity to learn about the past and present of the host country through coursework and cultural immersion. Study abroad participants also develop cross-cultural communication, problem-solving, and language skills that are highly sought-after in many careers.

ACADEMICS

History majors considering studying abroad are advised to work with their academic advisor to identify the best time to study abroad, based on the student's degree requirements and the courses offered on the study abroad program of the student's choice.

Students are encouraged to take coursework towards the European, non-European, global/comparative and elective major requirements abroad. Many study abroad programs offer unique history coursework focused on the host country/region that are not offered at UW-Whitewater and which may be personalized into the major with departmental approval.

In addition to satisfying major requirements, students may also fulfil minor, foreign language, or breadth requirements abroad.
