## WHY STUDY ABROAD?

Study abroad gives political science majors an opportunity to gain an understanding of political systems and international relations from a non-US perspective, while experiencing them first-hand. Study abroad participants also develop cross-cultural communication, problem-solving, and language skills that are highly sought-after in many political science careers.

## ACADEMICS

Political science majors considering studying abroad are advised to work with their academic advisor to identify the best time to study abroad, based on the student's degree requirements and the courses offered on the study abroad program of the student's choice.

Students are encouraged to take coursework towards the Comparative Politics (Area 3) and International Relations (Area 4), and elective major requirements abroad. Many study abroad programs offer unique coursework focused on the host country/region that are not offered at UW-Whitewater and which may be personalized into the major with departmental approval.

In addition to satisfying major requirements, students may also fulfill language and breadth requirements abroad.
