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Social Work

Goals:

1. To obtain a baseline understanding of social work students' knowledge of LEAP with particular focus on non-traditional social work students. The goal will be accomplished by conducting survey research.
2. To communicate LEAP and empower social work students. Communication of LEAP will be accomplished through inclusion of information in select social work course syllabi. Evaluation of communication efforts will be accomplished through additional survey procedures. A second goal is to assess barriers related to high-impact practice opportunities for non-traditional students. Empowering students will be accomplished by developing strategies to reduce barriers related to accessing LEAP opportunities.

Planned Actions:

Spring 2015

1. Creation of survey items that assesses knowledge of LEAP (completed February 15, 2015)
2. Submit for IRB approval for project (completed Feb 15, 2015)
3. Create electronic version of survey (completed Feb 28, 2015)
4. Literature review regarding disparities in information for non-traditional students (completed April 30, 2015) all will continue to work on this and report back at next meeting
5. Launch LEAP pre-survey (completed April 7, 2015)
6. Analyze pre-survey data (to be completed May 4-18, 2015)

Academic Year 2015-2016

1. Align course objectives with LEAP ELOs on course syllabi & activity sheets: HBSE I, Practice 2 & Research (August 30, 2015) Implement course syllabi in Fall 2015 (September 2015; first day of class)
2. Launch LEAP post-test survey (November 30, 2015)

3. Analyze post-survey data (December 2015/January 2016)
4. Dissemination of results (March-May 2016)
