RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF SHARED GOVERNANCE REPRESENTATION

WHEREAS shared governance gives representation to academic staff, university staff, faculty and students, who all take part in making significant decisions concerning the operation of the university;

WHEREAS shared governance is a unique and important aspect of the University of Wisconsin System, with its principles specifically noted in state statute and Board of Regents policy;

WHEREAS the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater strives to balance efficiency and representation by seeking governance appointments to University Committees, task forces, and/or special work groups;

WHEREAS governance appointees to University Committees, task forces, and/or special work groups serve as liaisons; representing the voice/perspective of their constituencies;

WHEREAS said governance appointees are not always elected members of each governing body;

WHEREAS true shared governance also requires the input of the respective constituents as represented by the elected governing body;

THEREFORE be it resolved that the recommendations, reports, or other actions of University Committees, task forces, and/or special work groups must also be presented to each of the full elected bodies (i.e., Academic Staff Assembly, University Staff Council, Faculty Senate, and/or Whitewater Student Government) for a vote to ensure authentic shared governance.
