II. PHYSICAL PROPERTIES

Appearance: Enviro Care Glass Cleaner is a free-flowing, purple liquid with a pleasant lavender blossom fragrance.

III. FIRE HAZARD

Enviro Care Glass Cleaner is not considered a fire hazard, nor will it support combustion.

Use standard firefighting techniques to extinguish fires involving this material (water spray, dry chemicals or foam).

IV. REACTIVITY DATA

Enviro Care Glass Cleaner is stable and non-reactive.

V. HEALTH HAZARD DATA

The principal route of exposure to Enviro Care Glass Cleaner is skin contact. Incidental skin contact is not expected to cause any significant irritation. Prolonged skin contact or eye contact may produce mild irritation.

Enviro Care Glass Cleaner is not listed as a carcinogen by NTP, IARC or OSHA.

VI. FIRST AID

For eye contact, flush with clear water for 15 minutes. For skin contact, wash with soap and water. If swallowed, consult a physician.

VII. PRECAUTIONS FOR SAFE HANDLING AND USE

Keep out of reach of children. Avoid eye and prolonged skin contact.

VIII. SPILL HANDLING

If Enviro Care Glass Cleaner is spilled, recover liquid with wet mop or wet/dry vacuum. Flush residue to sanitary sewer with water. Use care, as floor may become slippery.

IX. SPECIAL PROTECTION INFORMATION

Rubber, neoprene or vinyl gloves should be used to minimize skin contact. Splashproof chemical safety goggles should be used to eliminate the possibility of eye contact.
