# **Campus Awards Ceremony Awards**

# Coordinated by Career & Leadership Development

### **Student Involvement Award**

This award is to recognize the high level of involvement and contributions to the Whitewater campus & community by our Warhawks.

## **Greenhill Servant Leadership Award**

This award recognizes an individual student who by their leadership has demonstrated an outstanding commitment to others and service activities. A \$125 honorarium accompanies this award.

## Wyman Distinguished Student Leader Award

This is the highest leadership honor bestowed on an individual student for a variety of significant leadership roles during their collegiate tenure. The recipient of this award must be a graduating senior of the current academic year. A \$500.00 honorarium provided by the Walker Wyman Endowment accompanies this award.

# Peter J. Barrett Student Integrity Award

This award recognizes a student who has visibly demonstrated their commitment to the campus values, specifically showing their "commitment to personal and professional integrity." A \$125 honorarium accompanies this award.

#### Dr Fannie Hicklin Award DRAFT

This award recognizes a student that has demonstrated the characteristics that Dr Hicklin did during her 101 years of service. She was a devoted lifelong Warhawk that willingly and fearlessly through her dedication to others took on being "the first" in many aspects of her life. Hicklin embraced the responsibility with courage, heart and intellectual gusto which provided a diverse perspective to those around her. She was intellectually sharp, artistically gifted, classy, stylish, with a quick wit and a great sense of humor. She encouraged through her teaching that students should be professional, good listeners, speak clearly, believe in their ability and have had impact at UW-Whitewater in the moment and on it's future.

# **Buchholz Visionary Award (student or staff)**

Recognizes an individual who through service, time and collaboration sees the potential in others and what an organization can achieve.

## Reuben Klumb Outstanding Senior

This award is given in recognition of Dr. Reuben Klumb in honor of his more than 25 years of dedicated work with Homecoming. Each year these awards are given to two outstanding seniors, graduating (with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher) in academic year.

#### Greek Members of the Year

One fraternity and one sorority member from the Greek community are honored each year for their comprehensive dedication to the Greek system, UW-Whitewater, service, academics, and all that is virtuous of Greek Life.

### **Mackin Diversity Commitment Award**

Recognizes a student and staff who demonstrated continuous commitment to cultural diversity and inclusion; demonstrated respectful treatment in interactions and communications with others across identity boundaries; and demonstrated advocacy for marginalized groups. A \$125 honorarium accompanies this award for the student recipient.

## James R. Connor Leadership Grant

James R. Connor Student Leader Grant was designed to recognize and reward student leaders who have demonstrated a commitment to the development of their personal leadership skills. A \$1,989 honorarium accompanies this award. The JRC Leadership Grant is available for students with a minimum GPA of 3.0, have completed 48 credits by beginning of Spring Semester for the current academic year, and will be enrolled full time for following school year.

## Warhawk Ambassador Chancellor's Ambassador Scholarship

The Chancellor's Ambassador Scholarship (\$1,000) is awarded to a returning Ambassador. The essay will reflect their experience at UWW and as a Warhawk Ambassador. The evaluation criteria for applicants will be based on their service as a Warhawk Ambassador as well as the quality of their application.

### Warhawk Ambassador Service Award

This award is given to a graduating senior for their service and dedication to UW Whitewater and the Ambassador program. The winner is voted on by their fellow Warhawk Ambassadors.

# **Cartwright Scholarship:**

The purpose of this scholarship is to encourage and celebrate the leadership activities of female students. This scholarship shall be made only to female students enrolled at the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater who have demonstrated leadership potential as exhibited by their campus and community involvement.

## McGraw Award:

Named after Arthur McGraw, former dean of the School of Graduate Studies, this award was created in 1985 to honor outstanding student achievement. Specifically, the "recipient should be an outstanding, well-rounded UW-W graduate ready for the world of professional work and one who appears ready to contribute in a positive way to society".

**Outstanding Chapter Excellence Award – Student Organizations: Recognizes** the chapter who has gone above and beyond demonstrating their chapter values during the school year.

**Chancellor's Achievement Award – Student Organizations:** Recognizes one organization that has gone above and beyond the normal level of involvement, service and represents the "best" of what UW-Whitewater exemplifies.

**Outstanding Diversity Program – Student Organizations:** Recognizes organizations that have conducted meaningful diversity programs for the campus.

## Highest GPA – Greek Chapter

**Outstanding Service to Students - Faculty/Staff:** Recognizes a faculty or staff member who has gone above and beyond to encourage student success and involvement, and impacted students' lives by providing assistance, advice, or advocacy to students. \*Please note that staff whose service/involvement is an expectation of employment are not eligible.

### Warhawk Male & Female Athlete of the Year

The recipients of the Athletic Man/Woman of the Year are seniors who demonstrate the essence of a student-athlete at the NCAA Division III level. They have excelled athletically and academically throughout their careers and are role models for future Warhawks.

# **Outstanding Freshman Award**

Recognizing a freshman student who has experienced UW-Whitewater to the fullest during their first year. Students' application must align with the First Year Experience office's mission of transition, connection, integration, and development. Award Amount: \$1,000.00
