Training Clinic Meetings – Spring 2022

For Officials and Scorekeepers

Intramural Sports requires individuals interested in on-campus employment as an official (i.e. referee) and/or scorekeeper attend training clinic meetings prior to activity seasons beginning. Individuals do not need prior experience with either position to become a member of our team. These positions are not year-long commitments and individuals come to the training clinics for the activities they're interested in working. There are no formal interviews; simply submit an online interest form, come to a new officials meeting, contact our staff, etc. We will do our best to find a spot for everyone. Come to meetings and express interest early – spots fill fast!

Returning Official/Scorekeeper: Someone who has worked with our staff within the last twelve calendar months. Returners are given roster precedence for employment and do not need to attend a new officials meeting; simply attend training clinics.

New Official/Scorekeeper: Someone who has not worked with our staff before, OR has not worked with us within the last twelve calendar months. Must attend a NEW OFFICIALS meeting, even scorekeepers, prior to attending training clinics.

New Officials Meetings: Introduction to the positions and a chance for us to meet you/you to meet us! We will review the position descriptions, expectations, employment paperwork and upcoming/available opportunities for employment. Only need to attend one (1) of the following meetings listed. Choose how you'd like to attend (in-person or Webex). Webex links will be sent to those on our contact list.

Again, prospective staff members only need to attend one of these meetings. Options are available because we are possibly always looking to hire, depending on returning staff members and the number of registered teams.

Attendance in September generally makes a prospective/new staff member eligible for employment for the entire semester. Attendance in October means we can hire you starting the second quarter of the semester. We do look for individuals who are looking to work multiple activities throughout the academic year because a single activity season may only last 5-7 weeks.

Employment paperwork can be submitted any time by contact Matt Schneider at SchneideMD30@uww.edu. A paperwork review meeting must be scheduled with Matt if paperwork is not filled out and turned in during a new officials meeting. Paperwork is only required to be submitted once.

When attending a new officials meeting, it is recommended you bring your employment documents (i.e. I-9 documents). If you plan on working with Intramural Sports, bring these items with you to campus. What are acceptable I-9 documents I should bring? [Learn about that here.](#)
