2022-2023 Parking Permit Registration

RESIDENT

Parking Services offers the following permit types for On-Campus student residents

ANNUAL RESIDENT PERMIT

- Assigned parking in one of eight parking lots located near your residence hall.
- Parking is guaranteed at all times Monday through Friday.
- Parking elsewhere is prohibited. Exceptions explained in the full regulations

\$315.00 / school year

LOT 22 PERMIT

- Located by baseball field
 Parking elsewhere is prohibited. Exceptions explained in the full regulations.
- Starting January 1st, Lot 22 permits will need to park in Lot 24 until the end of spring semester. Parking Services will give instructions at time permit is picked up.

\$165.00 / school year

<u>All</u> permits <u>must</u> be purchased online at <u>www.uww.edu/parking</u>. Click on "Buy A Permit". Follow the prompts to order your permit. You will need to register at least one vehicle when purchasing a permit. You may register up to 3 vehicles <u>however</u>, the vehicles need to be registered to you or immediate family and **only 1 vehicle on campus at a time with the permit**.

Permits will be sold to upperclassmen on a first-come, first-serve basis, two days later; lowerclassmen will have an opportunity to purchase remaining permits on first-come, first serve basis.

Once permits are sold out, you will need to find other arrangements if you need your vehicle on campus. WE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO ACCOMMODATE.

If you have a state disabled placard or license plates, you will need to upload DMV documentation as proof when you purchase the accessible permit online. Parking retains the right to deny accessible permits if paperwork is not valid.

LOT 3 located directly behind Pulliam Hall, which has 16 reserved stalls, is available to Pulliam Hall residents. **LOT 9** located directly in front of Ma'iingan Hall, which has 29 reserved stalls, is available to Ma'iingan Hall residents. The cost of those stalls is \$515.00 and are reserved at all times; including weekends. You must park in the space that coincides with your permit number.

Any on campus-resident can choose to purchase a Lot 22 for the lower price.

Parking Services retains the right to override any lot choices that are not correct for the resident hall indicated.

Ownership of parking permits are retained by UW-Whitewater Parking Services. Resale, transfer, or duplication is prohibited. Use is restricted to registered to permit holder. Unauthorized use will result in a fine, revocation, and prosecution for theft/misuse under 943.20(1)(a) WI State Statutes of UWS 18.08 (8).

• A parking permit is required for all motorcycles, mopeds, and scooters



- Annual Cycle permits cost \$55.00. If you purchase a vehicle permit, the Cycle permit cost is \$5.00.
 - Parking in auto stalls is prohibited for all motorcycles, mopeds, and scooters
 - Cycles, mopeds, and scooters must park in areas designated for their use and must have a permit

What happens next?

PERMIT PICK UP

Once the permit is purchased online, the permit will need to be picked up at the Parking Services office located in the Visitor Center building during our business hours. It is your responsibility to pick up your permit and must show your UWW ID in order to pick up the permit. Early Arrivals (RAs, Peer Mentors, LIT members, athletes, etc) may pick up their permits after arrival.

Permits that were purchased but not claimed by Friday, September 9th will be considered forfeit and issued to people on the waiting list.

Visitor and Parent Parking

Visitor parking permits are required between 11:00 pm Sunday and 5:00 p.m. on Friday

Visitors and parents must obtain a parking permit before parking on campus. Visitor permits are \$5.00 per day and are available:

- In the Parking office located in the Visitor Center during normal business hours
- Online at <u>www.uww.edu/parking</u> and choose "Visitor".
- Visitor permits are <u>not</u> valid to park in the on-campus resident (yellow) parking lots (2R, 3, 8, 9R, 17, 20, 22, and 23) and are <u>not</u> valid for overnight parking in any lot.
- Purchased from the kiosk located in the service drive 24 hours-a-day. Hourly (up to 4 hours) permits are available as well through the kiosk.
 - \circ Permits through the kiosk, will allow overnight parking in lot 19 only.
