What My Permit Pays For.....

- 1. Debt Service Loans derived from the purchase of properties
- 2. Capital Projects Costs associated with major lot projects, such as resurfacing, replacement or building
- 3. Maintenance/Other Costs associated with routine lot needs, such as snow plowing, striping or patching
- <u>Overhead Charges</u> Direct support provided to other UW-Whitewater campus services used by Parking Services
- 5. <u>Police Charges</u> Direct support provided to the UW-Whitewater Police Department for enforcement and event control
- 6. <u>Permanent Salaries</u> The salaries paid to the three full-time employees
- 7. <u>Student Salaries</u> The salaries paid to the 8-10 student employees (3-4 Front Desk, 5-6 CSO's)
- 8. <u>Fringe</u> Insurance and benefit costs for the three full-time employees
- 9. Bus Service Contractual costs associated with the UW-Whitewater to Milwaukee bus service
