LOCK YOUR DOORS AND KEEP TRACK OF YOUR VALUABLES: DON'T INVITE CRIME INTO YOUR LIFE!

#### OF ALL OF THE THEFTS THAT HAVE OCCURRED AT UWW SO FAR IN 2019:

- O 42% RESULTED FROM PRIVATE PROPERTY BEING LEFT IN PUBLIC PLACES, AND THEN STOLEN.
- 21% RESULTED FROM LEAVING THE DOOR TO A ROOM OR VEHICLE UNLOCKED.
- THESE TWO AREAS ACCOUNT FOR 63% OF ALL THEFTS SO FAR IN 2019!

OF ALL OF THE THEFTS FROM RESIDENCE HALL ROOMS AND VEHICLES THAT HAVE OCCURRED AT UWW SO FAR IN 2019: 75% RESULTED FROM LEAVING THE DOOR UNLOCKED.

NATIONWIDE, ALMOST 30% OF BURGLARIES ARE COMMITTED BY THOSE WHO ENTER THROUGH AN UNLOCKED DOOR OR WINDOW!




