

**SAMPLE Four-Year Plan**  
**ART BA- Art History Emphasis**  
**FALL 2020 Requirements**

The curriculum in the BA-Art with an Art History Emphasis is somewhat flexible in that there are some required sequences of courses, while also allowing students to move through other coursework in many ways. This four-year plan illustrates one possible pathway an incoming freshman student could follow to complete the degree in four years. This is not an official document and is not the only way that a BA-Art with an Art History Emphasis can be completed in four years.
