

Scholarship Auditions & Portfolio Review Information

Auditions/Interviews are required for any new freshman applying for a scholarship from the UW-Whitewater Theatre/Dance Department. The Department will be conducting these auditions or interviews for Freshman Theatre Scholarships on **Sunday**, **Feb. 25**, **2024**. Applicants should be students who are applying to UW-Whitewater for admission as a Theatre Major in the Fall of 2024.

All applicants are asked to submit the following items:

- 1. The application form, found below.
- 2. High School transcript record.
- 3. One Reference Letter.
- 4. Theatre Experience Resume.

ALL MATERIALS ARE DUE NO LATER THAN 2/16/24. You will then be required to attend the Scholarship Auditions/Interviews event on **Sunday**, **February 25**, **2024**.

ACTORS and ACTOR/SINGERS

Students are asked to prepare an audition of a monologue or two contrasting monologues, which will best demonstrate their acting ability. The audition should 2-3 minutes in length, including an introduction. Singing is NOT required. If a song is used, it should be limited to 16 bars of music. Please bring recorded music with your own playback device. A single chair will be provided. All other props or individuals in the scene should be mimed as needed. Following the prepared audition, there will be an opportunity for discussion with the adjudicators. Auditions will take place in a space to be determined in the Greenhill Center of the Arts.

DESIGNERS/TECHNICIANS/STAGE MANAGERS

Students should be prepared to discuss their resumes with faculty designers and should be prepared to show their portfolio materials, such as photographs, drawings or designs. Portfolio Reviews/Interviews will take place in a space to be determined in the Greenhill Center.
