Two annual scholarship awards for students with <u>Senior standing</u>: amounts vary around \$2,000 plus \$500 for research each.

- A. Biology major at full time status for period covered by the scholarship
- B. Incoming Freshman: full-time student who maintained an overall academic average of 3.5 or better while in high school. Preference will be given to students who have received honors or awards in high school or have been active in community service projects.
- C. Continuing Sophomore and Sophomore/upper level students must:
  - 1. Maintain a GPA of 3.4 or better.
  - 2. Demonstrate progress towards degree as measured by an academic advisor within the Biology department.
  - 3. Participate in extracurricular professional development.
  - 4. Complete an essay indicating why they wish to study the field of biology.
