you did and how it will be useful to your future career and education. Submit this within two weeks of the semester end date (semester you are requesting credit). This retrospective should be sent to the Biology Main Office ADA.

d) the final steps in the internship will be to complete the internship evaluation, a link will be provided when your retrospective is received. Biology will send an evaluation of your performance to the internship supervisor for our own assessment purposes.

e) your internship will show up as a Bio 493 in your AAR.
