DONALD L. AND ALLENE L. GRAHAM SCHOLARSHIP

A. Eligibility

1. Major and minor requirements:
 - a. declared major in history, or
 - b. declared major in Broadfield Social Studies (BFSS) with a 33-credit history emphasis, or a 21-credit history emphasis, or
 - c. declared minor in history
2. Minimum grade point average at time of application:
 - a. overall GPA - 3.00
 - b. all history credits - 3.00
3. Credit requirements at time award begins:
 - a. minimum of 60 university credits completed, and
 - b. senior history majors and BFSS (33 cr. hist. emphasis): 20 history cr.
 - c. senior history minors and BFSS (21 cr. hist. emphasis): 15 history cr.
 - d. junior history majors and BFSS (31 cr. hist. emphasis): 12 history cr.
 - e. junior history minors and BFSS (21 cr. hist. emphasis): 9 history cr.
4. Clarification of item 3 above:

A student may apply for and receive a scholarship although he or she will not meet the specific requirements in A. 3., at the beginning of the subsequent fall semester. If the credit requirements are met after completing the fall semester, an award will be paid at the beginning of the second semester, if the student satisfies all eligibility requirements.

B. Department Stipulations

1. The scholarships will be awarded on a one-year, academic basis.
2. An individual may receive the scholarship for a maximum of three years, but must reapply for the second and third year and compete for the scholarship on an equal basis with other applicants.

C. Application

1. A completed application packet must include:
 - a. A complete application form. (Form available at <https://www.uww.edu/cls/departments/history#ForStudents#scholarships-and-awards>)
 - b. A current UW-Whitewater unofficial transcript printed off the WINS system; and
 - c. Transcripts from all other universities and colleges attended.
2. The deadline to apply is 5:00 P.M. on the last Monday in February.
3. Complete application packets must be submitted to the Department of History, Laurentide Hall 5221 no later than 5:00 P.M. on the last Monday in February.
