LODGING:

Three lodging options for student researchers, faculty mentors or other conferees –

- Goodhue Hall (UWW Residence Hall for campus visitors):
 - 2 Deluxe Suites (Queen sized bed, microwave, mini-refrigerator, in-room full bath with shower) @ \$35/night, linens provided.
