- a. Chair's Announcements:
 - i. Informational updates:
 - 1. Bi-weekly pay will start in July.
 - 2. VSIP talk to Sahyun if you have any questions.
 - 3. UWW Budget has a (current) target reduction of \$17.3M goal from this year's initially approved budget (and this year's budget target is a \$5.4M reduction from this year's initially approved budget.) CoL&S has a ~\$14M budget but 97% of the budget is salary so there are few options for reduction.
 - 4. Reminder: FMLA/EFMLA Family medical leave act provides 2 weeks unpaid, 10 weeks paid. EFMLA is only available for Child Care needs due to Covid related issues. Elder care falls under FMLA. contact benefits@uww.edu
 - 5. COVID Leave: for exposure, quarantining, positive test results or illness provides 80 hours of leave (then can use FMLA if need additional leave.)

 - 7. Checking your COVID Furlough days:

Fall furlough days that have been approved show up in the Time -> View/Edit Requests. However, Spring dates do not! To figure out how many days you have actually taken in 2020, look at your December Earnings Statement, take your monthly pay and divide by 22 (22 pay

days per month). Then take your Furlough FAASLI Unpaid value by the daily rate, and that is the number of days you have taken.

Example: Looking at the December 01, 2020 earnings statement, in the Hours and Earnings section:

FAASLI Reg Current Earnings 5060.00 so the daily pay is 5060/22 = \$230.

Next look at the Hours and Earnings,

Furlough FAASLI Unpaid YTD Earnings -1380

so the number of days of credited furlough is 1360/230 = 6 furlough days taken.
