## APPLIED RESEARCH CERTIFICATE

Applied research is a project performed to answer a question for a client, such as a university unit, non-profit organization, or government agency. For example, to perform a "needs assessment" among clients for a non-profit org, or to assess "satisfaction levels" among constituents of a campus unit. This type of research entails presenting your findings to the client at the finish. For this certificate, be sure and get approval on your "applied research" project (i.e., the 498R or PSYCH 394) to ensure it fits the "applied" research definition, and to get your client evaluation in the end as well.
