Departments are urged to get their Gen Ed electives recertified this spring, if possible. (There are over 300 Gen Ed elective courses in total!)

- 3. Angela Harlan from Mathematics discussed the UW System initiative to standardize the gateway college-level mathematics courses offered across the system around three courses: 1) Statistics; 2) Quantitative Reasoning (MATH 139); and 3) College Algebra (MATH 150). These proposed changes will be reviewed by a UWW/U-Rock team this summer; this review will include a campus "summit" in late June. Stay tuned. Angela also reminded the committee that new cut scores for math placement will be going into effect in Fall.
