A. Approval of October 22, 2020 Minutes

B. Announcements

1. Currency of catalog proposals due by the end of December.
2. Ellen Davis noted that the AAR for newly revised Biology major is not correct. Annie LaValley added that it is important to double-check AARs for new or revised programs as there seem to be many problems this year. For new/revised programs with a Spring 2021 effective term, AARs will be correct only after update is complete. Remember that the CourseLeaf program page is the most reliable source for double-checking the accuracy of the AAR. You can also look at the history of changes. Look for the affected term in the AAR. Check the BAs, BSs, and each separate emphasis.

Zimmerman/McGovern moved, motion passed.

D. Computer Science

1. New Program – [COMPUTER SCIENCE – APPLIED COMPUTING EMPHASIS \(BA/BS\)](#)
(tabled from 10/22/20 meeting)
Oster/Gimbel moved to bring the proposal back. Motion passed unanimously.
Oster presented an update on changes made:
 - a. Restructured courses in the major-Major GPA will be counted only on major courses
 - b. ITSCM consultation received
 - c. Introduction text was edited

- d. Discussion: Havas-Is it possible to have articulations with other campuses? Oster- We are working with Waukesha Technical College first. There are no other 2-year campuses. Credits transfer in as direct equivalents.

Proposal was unanimously approved.

E. Languages & Literatures/World Languages and Cultures

1. New Course- [SPANISH 375: INTRODUCTION SPANISH-ENGLISH; ENGLISH-SPANISH TRANSLATION](#) (tabled from 10/22/20 meeting)

Betty/House moved to bring the proposal back. Motion passed.

Hachten explained the changes made:

- a. Changed to a more concise course title
- b. Pre-requisites were discussed
- c. Syllabus added to CourseLeaf
- d. Staffing implications discussed
- e. Course description was edited
- f. Discussion: The first sentence in the second paragraph is not complete.

Proposal was unanimously approved with minor edits to be completed by committee secretary and chair.

F. Math

1. New Course- [Math 93: Support for Quantitative Reasoning](#)

2. Course Revision- [Math 139: Quantitative Reasoning](#)

Harlan/Davis moved to approve F1 and F2; motion passed.

Harlan explained the co-requisite model that will replace MATH 041 for most students so that they will be able to take a college-credit bearing course for their first required math class.

- a. Math 93: 2 credits. For students who place below the 139 cut.
- b. Student takes Math 93 and Math 139 together.
- c. Discussion: Harlan-Should we make 93 repeatable? What if a student could audit the course?
- d. Due to pre-requisite and co-requisites, students need to enroll in Math 93 first, and then 139.
- e. Hachten-Specific test score ranges will place students into Math 93.
- f. Johnson-Why is it Math 93 and not 39? Harlan-There was concern over confusion if 139 was typed incorrectly as 39, etc.
- g. The majority of students now take Math 139. Harlan explained Math 139 is required in both CoBE and CoEPS.
- h. Harlan will add Business in summary of changes.

3. New Course- [Math 124: Support for College Algebra](#)

4. Course Revision- [Math 142: College Algebra](#)

Harlan/Gregory moved to approve proposals F3 & 4, motion passed.

Harlan explained Math 124 is 1 credit and supports Math 142.

Harlan will update syllabus to 124.

- a. Would like to add the pre-requisite of "C" or better in Math 139.

5. Course Revision- [Math 343: Applied Probability Theory](#)

Harlan/House moved to approve proposal F5 Math. Motion passed unanimously.

Harlan explained the course revision.

- a. Oster-Computer Science was consulted and the department supports the change.

Discussion:

McGovern-To update a course title, do we update the syllabus? Hachten- No, that is not necessary.
