A. Approval of April 15, 2021 Minutes

B. Announcements

- 3. Wesley: Do we need to elect reps to University Curriculum Committee? Or is that done at some other time? Liz-Yes! We do need to do so. David Havas, Ted Gimbel, and Zach Oster are the three who have been making substantive additions to the UCC. All three have agreed to continue on.

2. Course Change BIOLOGY 446: ORGANIC EVOLUTION

- b. Ellen explained the course change as housekeeping. Moving this back to the proper CL section in the course proposal.
- c. Reps from 3 departments should look at courses with discussion or recitation section, courses need to be noted in CL as lecture, discussion, and lab.
- d. There is no component in CL for recitation. These should be reflected in the course component as **discussion**.
- e. Nathan-This had been set as seminar with no discussion. What is seminar then? Liz-Seminar is an alternative to lecture. If a course is listed as a lecture in CL and WINS, it can be run as a seminar. This will be recorded to System as such. Seminar is publicly signaling your intent to run as a seminar. You are not prevented from running as a Lecture.
 - 1. If designated as a seminar, course cap does not necessarily apply as lower cap.
