International Scholarship for Semester Study Abroad

This scholarship is awarded to students who are approved for study abroad participation with either a UW-W exchange program or via an affiliated study abroad program provider. Applicants must have sophomore status or higher, a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0, and a major or pre-major in Business. Scholarship funding is provided by the College.

Amount: \$500-\$1,000

Completed applications must be returned to the Center for Global Education, Hyland Hall 1227, no later than April 15th for fall study abroad participation and November 15th for spring and summer study abroad participation.

Scholarship for Travel Study Programs

This scholarship is awarded to students who will participate in the UW-W Travel Study Program. Applicants must have sophomore status or higher, a GPA of at least 3.0, and a major or pre-major in Business. Scholarship funding is provided by the College.

Amount: \$500

Applicants must have sophomore status or higher, a GPA of at least 3.0, and a major in Business or pre-Business.
