

Change to “Uncompensated Labor” ad hoc Committee
Approved by the Faculty Senate Executive Committee on 2020-07-20

The Faculty Senate Executive Committee hereby establishes and charges the “Uncompensated Labor” ad hoc committee.

This committee should be comprised of:

- 1 faculty member from each college, including at least one department chair and at least one program coordinator

This committee is charged to:

1. Document the impact of Covid19 on labor and compensation, including:
 - a. The types and amount of additional labor required of faculty and instructional academic staff during the spring 2020 semester as a result of the move to remote delivery in response to the Covid19 pandemic.
 - b. The types and amount of additional labor required of faculty and instructional academic staff during the summer 2020 semester in preparing to teach in Fall 2020 where they might need to teach face-to-face, online, or some combination of both.
 - c. The additional work required for Department Chairs-- redoing schedules, approving furloughs, etc.
2. Make recommendations about how to address these findings to the Faculty Salary Committee.
3. Present their findings and recommendation at a Faculty Senate meeting during the 2020-2021 academic year.
