## **Charge to Digital Purple Book ad hoc Committee**

Approved at the 2020-10-13 meeting of the Faculty Senate

The Faculty Senate hereby formally establishes an ad hoc committee on Digital Purple Books.

The committee membership should consist of:

1. At least one faculty member from each college

## This committee is charged to:

- 1. Investigate options for making the Purple Book process digital. This should include:
  - a. Collection of documents by the individual faculty member and ability to include various forms of documentation
  - b. Dissemination of the Purple Book to Department members for review
  - c. Submission and approval process
  - d. Secure storage of files
- 2. Consult with the Constituency Standards Committees
- 3. Consult with Deans, Provost, and/or Chancellor
- 4. Examine similar processes at other institutions
- 5. Examine any rules and policies related to Purple Books would be impacted
- 6. Make a recommendation to the Faculty Senate during the 2020-2021 academic year
