



## 2021 Summer Financial Aid Application Directions

### Overview:

The summer term consists of several sessions, with classes consisting of 3-week sessions, 6-week sessions, 9-week sessions, and 12-week sessions. Financial Aid for the summer term is awarded separately from the fall 2020 and spring 2021 terms, and there are differences between eligibility for aid during the summer term and the academic year process. Federal grant and loan eligibility are very limited for summer.

### General Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible for and awarded federal financial aid for summer, you must meet all the following requirements:

- Have a completed and fully processed 2020-2021 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Be enrolled in courses for the summer term and have submitted this 2021 Summer Application.
- Maintaining Satisfactory Academic Progress.

Students who graduate(d) in the spring 2021 term are not eligible for summer financial aid.

### Federal Pell Grant Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible for and awarded a Federal Pell Grant, you must:

- Meet the general eligibility requirements defined above.
- Be an undergraduate student who has not yet reached the lifetime Pell Grant limit.
- If you were enrolled full-time (12 credits or more) in both fall and spring, you must enroll in 6 credits or more for summer term.
- If you were not enrolled full-time for both fall and spring, you may have limited Pell Grant eligibility if enrolled in at least 3 credits.

### Federal Subsidized and Unsubsidized Direct Loan Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible for and awarded a Federal Subsidized or Unsubsidized Direct Loans, you must:

- Meet the general eligibility requirements defined above.
- Be enrolled in at least 6 credits for the summer 2021 term.
- Not already been awarded the maximum loan amount for your grade level for the academic year. Maximum loan amounts are:

Grade Level	Dependent Student	Independent Student
Freshman (0-23 credits)	\$5,500 (no more than \$3,500 Subsidized)	\$9,500 (no more than \$3,500 Subsidized)
Sophomore (24-59 credits)	\$6,500 (no more than \$4,500 Subsidized)	\$10,500 (no more than \$4,500 Subsidized)
Juniors & Senior (60+ credits)	\$7,500 (no more than \$5,500 Subsidized)	\$12,500 (no more than \$5,500 Subsidized)
Graduate Students	N/A	\$20,500

- If your grade level will change after spring term, please submit your application after spring grades have been posted.

### Additional Notes:

- Summer tuition charges are due June 18, 2021. Tuition is due for all sessions in which you are registered, even if that session starts after the due date and even if your financial aid has not yet credited your account.
- Your financial aid will not pay your charges until the dates listed on the next page, based on which session your first class is in.
- If you drop courses after the summer term has started, we will be required to reduce or cancel your financial aid which will result in you owing funds back to UW-W.
- If you do not meet the requirements as described above, you may want to consider the [Parent PLUS Loan](#), [Private Loans](#), or [Graduate PLUS Loan](#). To be eligible for Parent PLUS and Graduate PLUS loans, you must be enrolled in 6 or more credits for the summer term.
