**Post-Masters School Counseling Internship 6 credits**

Interns will complete 600 clock hours of supervised experience each semester at a school. The intern will engage in individual and group counseling, developmental guidance activities, and consultation, as well as a variety of other activities that a regularly employed staff member in the setting would be expected to perform. Can repeat once.

Prereq: Masters in Counseling-School emphasis, completion of READING 764, SPECED 205, SPECED 721, COUNSED 738, COUNSED 741, COUNSED 793 and permission of instructor

**To:**

**Post-Masters Counseling Internship 1.5-3 credits**

Interns will complete supervised experience in their emphasis area (community agency, higher education setting, or school). The intern will engage in individual, group counseling, and family counseling, and consultation, as well as a variety of other activities that a regularly employed counselor in the setting would be expected to perform. Can repeat once.

Prereq: Masters in Counseling or the equivalent

II. Justification for action

Changes have been made to clarify the focus of the course and to update the language to more accurately represent the present terminology in the counseling field. Certificate programs have required a post-masters experience for students in other emphasis areas.
