Proposal: Delete current Additional Admission Requirement (Applicants must hold or be eligible for a regular license in the State of Wisconsin for teaching in public schools.)

Justification:

The TAES program is intended to assist licensed teachers and other professionals working with youth in recognizing and developing the knowledge, skills, and dispositions necessary to work in alternative education settings. Program participants may choose to apply for a WI-952 add-on license, but this is not a requirement of the program. Participants outside of Wisconsin will have no need for the WI-952 license. Participants working for service agencies, e.g., Boys and Girls Clubs, may not have the regular teaching license necessary for the add-on WI-952, but may still gain valuable knowledge, skills, and dispositions through participation in the TAES certificate program.
