(For example, a freshman would complete at least four tables beginning with Freshman Year; a sophomore would complete at least three tables beginning with Sophomore Year, etc.)
- 3 Refer to the Honors Courses Rotation Sheet on page 3.

Important Notes:

- Please note that you can take special Honors electives (e.g. Honors 291, Honors 296, and Honors 498) toward the 21 credits. These courses are repeatable, usually up to six credits.
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.4 must be maintained throughout your college career in order to graduate with University Honors. Further, you must achieve a "B" or higher in Honors courses/sections (except for Honors electives, which are graded S/NC) and in courses in which you complete an H-Option project in order to receive Honors credit for the course.
