

Connect Your Roku

Make sure your Roku device has been registered at mydevices.uww.edu.

You will need the MAC address of your device.

Where is Mac address on Roku TV?

A **MAC address** is a set of six 2-digit pairs separated by colons (e.g. 00:0D:0A:1H:3G:5C). One set is for your wireless connection and one set is for your wired/Ethernet connection, if your **Roku** player model supports Ethernet. Alternatively, from the **Roku** home screen, select Settings > System > About. It is called the Device ID.

1. Turn on your TV and tune to the correct HDMI input.
2. Power on your Roku player or TV.
3. From the Roku Home screen, select **Settings > Network > Connect and Activate now**
4. Select Private Network and type in UWWPlay. It is case-sensitive.
5. There is no password for this network.
6. Three green checkmarks will indicate that your setup was successful.
7. If it asks what are you, then choose “I am at home”.

You are now connected.
