All:

- New Computer Models
  - PCs – New Laptops, and Desktops
    - Finalizing this week.

- Adobe:
  - Initial synchronization to give fac/staff federated access to the All Apps plan is in place. I am working on documentation and then we will announce to users. – On hold, pending IDM issues not syncing all fac/staff. T3 IDM looking into.
    - Labs/Classrooms will still have serialized licenses
    - Office computers will have the option for serialized licenses (might go away in new ETLA Next fall), or named user
      - Be careful if it is an office computer, which students use, you will need the serialized license in this case.

- If a user logs into a serialized install it can wipe out the serialized license. There is the “Adobe Creative Cloud – Enterprise License (Expires 11-19)” available to re-serialize the license.
    - Adobe has committed to a new student-licensing model which is to work with named-user only applications like XD, Dimension and Captivate 2017.
  - Restructuring:
    - After submitting our proposals for restructuring colleges has decided, they will be handling everything related to the transition.
    - UW-Colleges still supporting and purchasing existing UW-Rock fac/staff equipment
    - UW-Whitewater is taking part in various IT restructuring functional groups with other campuses.
