



Workstation Management Meeting – 11/12/18

All:

- New Computer Models
 - PCs – New Laptops, and Desktops added to catalog
 - HP Discontinued the EliteBook 820, it has been replaced with the 830 which has a 13.3” Display
 - ProBook 640 – No longer offers an optical drive. Do we still want to use the Probook 640, or go with the eliteBook 840 which has a 14” Display (Between the 830 and 850).
 - New Mac Models
 - Apple added several new models. Holding off until software is tested for Mojave as these will ship with Mojave.
- Spring Software – I’m behind on these, but am working on getting them sent this week.
 - We will be starting to look at VPAT compliance per Administrative Affairs directive.
 - A governance group is reviewing the policy and I will have more details as to what the process looks like if something is not compliant. To get a head of the curve though we will at least collect the compliance status for now.

 - -Adobe: Engaged Citrix on Adobe applications and working to see what we can do to get those functional in our environment
- 10.10 Macs will be targeted next for upgrade – Updates?
 - Next release of Cisco Jabber does not support 10.10, which causes issues for a campus wide push.
 - ~70
- Adobe:
 - Initial synchronization to give fac/staff federated access to the All Apps plan is in place. I am working on documentation and then we will announce to users. – On hold, pending IDM issues not syncing all fac/staff. T3 IDM looking into.
 - Labs/Classrooms will still have serialized licenses
 - Office computers will have the option for serialized licenses (might go away in new ETLA Next fall), or named user
 - Be careful if it is an office computer, which students use, you will need the serialized license in this case.

- If a user logs into a serialized install it can wipe out the serialized license. There is the “Adobe Creative Cloud – Enterprise License (Expires 11-19)” available to re-serialize the license.
- Adobe has committed to a new student-licensing model, which is to work with named-user only applications like XD, Dimension and Captivate 2017.
