



Workstation Management Meeting – 6/18/18

All:

- Lab/Class imaging and software
 - Currently working on finalizing the base images, then we will engage tech liaisons for test devices for the remainder of packages.
 - Joel to handle a far majority of Mac imaging with the migration to DEP
 - If interested in assisting it will be good experience in learning the new system.
- Citrix
 - iOS file access
 - iOS 11+ ONLY
- 10.10 Macs will be targeted next for upgrade – Updates?
 - Next release of Cisco Jabber does not support 10.10 which causes issues for a campus wide push.
 - ~90
- High Sierra
 - Starting with Clean provision process
 - Likely will NOT offer upgrade to any devices that are currently available in our DEP instance.
 - This better positions us for future requirements from Apple for High Sierra +
 - Once enrolled through DEP future upgrades will be available again.
 - Lab and class Macs should all be available in DEP
 - Future training for our tech liaisons that currently do imaging, over the summer.
- Adobe (handout)
 - Later this summer we will be announcing named-user licensing for faculty and staff at UW-Whitewater. This will allow fac/staff to install and update apps as they like from the Adobe Creative Cloud application. Fac/staff will be able to install it on personal devices. You can only have two instances activated at once, but it is a very simple process when the application launches to deactivate from other systems.
 - At this time, students are NOT covered for named-user licenses in our existing Adobe Enterprise License contract. The existing contract ends in 2019 (I think) and system will be revisiting how we will address this moving forward.
 - Labs and classrooms will still be using serialized licenses.
 - This becomes very important on non-lab/class imaged devices used by both students and fac/staff. If the Adobe applications were installed using the creative cloud

application, students will not be able to access them, as they will require a named-user license.

- In these situations, you will need to install the serialized versions from self-service until Adobe figures out how not to cause mass confusion for their customer base.
