

UW-Whitewater Mobile App




A new way to run your Campus Scavenger Hunt!

This scavenger hunt utilizes the new UW-Whitewater App to help students both explore campus and find out how useful the app can be.

It's a mix of text, GPS, and photo missions using the App as a tool to explore campus resources. To see a list of the Scavenger Hunt Missions, go to the last page of this document.

Instructions

Before Class: Create the Game

1. Follow <https://gsch.se/game/ed87fda5383b4372ba653d23e006088c/share/> to copy the Campus Scavenger Hunt with the UW-Whitewater App game in GooseChase.
2. Select 
3. Sign in if you have an account. If you don't, you can sign up using your **UWW email** address (please do not make your password the same as your UWW password).
4. Edit the game to your specifications; you can add and delete missions. This game is set up to allow participants to create their own teams.
5. Set game start and stop time to make your game LIVE.
6. Make note of the game code – found at the bottom left while you are in Setup

During Class: Run the Game

1. Have students download the UW-Whitewater App from the App Store or Google Play. Most should already have it from Warhawk Welcome.
2. Break the class up into teams. Have at least one team member download the GooseChase App. That person will submit their team's responses. More team members can join the game, but only one must—they will be given a team Access Code. See instructions below for more information.
3. Students can find the game by searching name "Campus Scavenger Hunt with the UW-Whitewater App" or entering game code.
4. The Scavenger Hunt missions do not need to be completed in order.
5. You and participants can see rankings and real-time activity updates.
6. You can award teams bonus points when they do well or penalize them when they miss the mark.

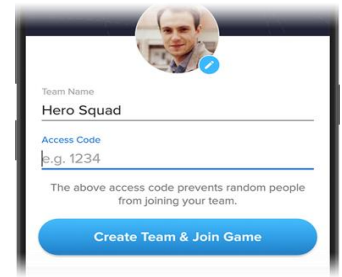
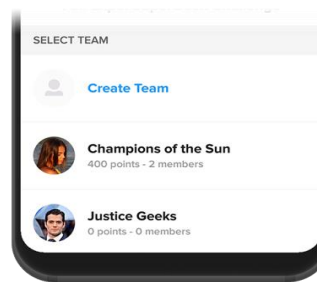
1. Download the GooseChase Android or iPhone app.



2. Choose to play as a guest or register for a personal account with your UWW email. When registering, choose a password that's different than your campus password.

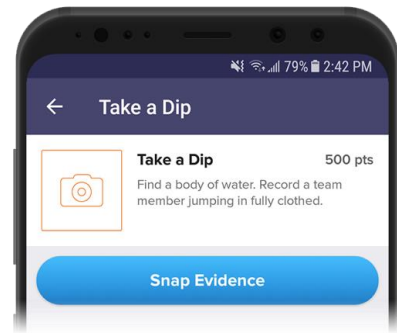


3. Find the game by entering the Game Code or by tapping the search icon and enter the name of the game: Campus Scavenger Hunt using the UW-Whitewater App.



4. Tap Select Team and Join Game then Create Team—if others will be joining your team, make note of the Access Code for your team. Other team members can submit evidence, after tapping Select Team and Join Game, they will tap on your team's name and enter the Access Code.

5. Once in the game, you'll be presented with the missions you or your team are attempting to complete. Mission types can include Photo/Video, Text, or GPS check in. To complete a mission, select it from the list and hit the "Snap Evidence" button.

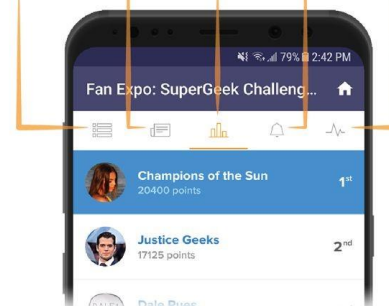


6. Using the navigation tabs, you can keep track of how you are doing via the activity feed and the leaderboard, see notifications from the game organizer, or review (and resubmit) your previous submissions.

Campus Scavenger Hunt with the UW-Whitewater App

A list of the activities in the GooseChase game available for you to use.

Mission	Description
Get the app and prove it!	Before leaving class, download the UW-Whitewater App if you don't already have it (search for UW-Whitewater). To complete this mission, one team member submits a photo of the team showing their phones with the app open.
Check out your Class Schedule	View your agenda--do you see your courses listed correctly? Complete this mission by answering yes or no. If not, let us know what's wrong by using the App Feedback link!
Game on!	You and a few friends have decided to play intramural volleyball. How do you find out more? To complete this mission, tell us what icon you used to find out more and which department will help you get involved.
Don't hesitate to get assistance	Students with both physical and learning disabilities can go here for assistance. All students can volunteer to help. To complete this mission, take a photo outside the office of the department that helps students with disabilities.
Movie Night	You find out there's an awesome movie showing in the UC and want to go with your friends. To complete this mission, find the room where the movie will play and snap a group photo.
Don't get towed	You decide to bring a car to school either for a few nights or for the year. To complete this mission, go to the location of where you can get a parking pass.
Need a job? Want to get involved?	This office coordinates all the student organizations and manages Handshake, the student job board. To complete this mission, take a group photo outside this office.
Find a fun Campus Event	Navigate to the Campus tab and View All events. Find one that looks fun. Complete this mission by taking a group photo at the location of where the event will be held (even if it isn't happening today). Go the extra mile by adding the event to your calendar and inviting someone to go with you!
Having trouble?	To complete this mission, find the building that houses the Tutorial Center and take a group photo outside.
Living on campus	You live on campus and are having difficulty with a roommate, maintenance issue, or have general questions. To complete this mission, tell us what office can help? Tap the icon for the office to find out more.
Send a status update to your Peer Mentor	Are you having fun yet? Let your peer mentor know how the hunt is going! Send them a message via the app. Include questions if you have any. To complete this mission, have one team member take a photo of the message sent to your peer mentor.
Find the building that houses these offices	This building is where you go to pay your student bill and get financial aid. Complete this mission by checking in by GPS.
We hope this never happens to you	You lose your ID and you need to have a new one made. To complete the mission, go to where you can get a new ID and take a group photo. While you are headed there, check out where you can use your Purple Points!
Help me decide!	You have not decided on a major, therefore you are considered 'undecided.' You need to go here to figure out what courses you need to take next semester. To complete this mission, take a photo at this office.
Official Grades	This office is the official record keeper of the University. This is where you would go if you need a transcript or enrollment verification. To complete this mission, take a photo outside this office.
