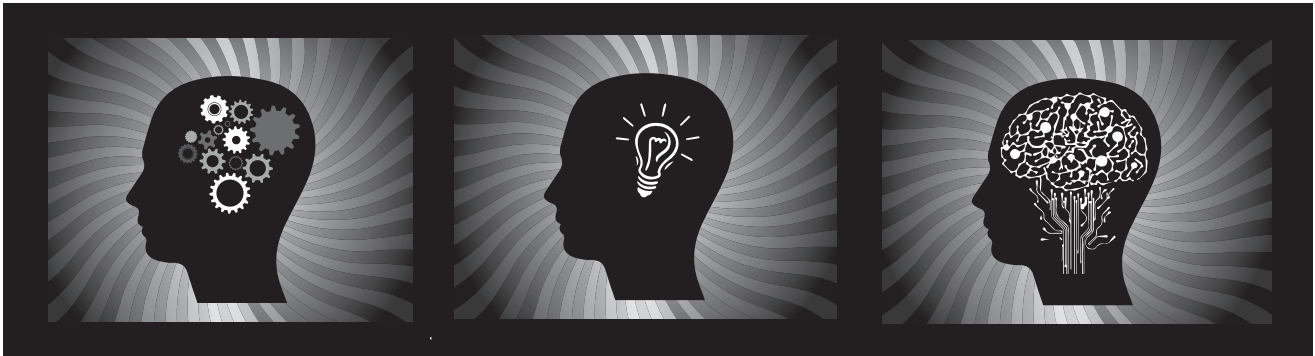


Practicing and Assessing Critical Thinking in the Classroom
