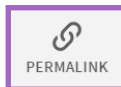
Free Wifi Hotspots for Students

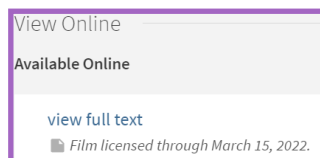
