

WING Tuition Grant Maximum Caps for the 2025-2026 Academic Year

The UW System has released the UW Madison Tuition Schedule for residents. Accordingly, the maximum caps for the 2025-2026 academic year for the Wisconsin National Guard Tuition Grant have been updated. Please see the table below. These rates are in effect between September 1, 2025 - August 31, 2026.

Standard Tuition (most programs)	\$5,253.24	\$437.77
School of Business Administration	\$6,828.24	\$569.02
Certificate of Business	\$5,410.68	\$450.89
School of Engineering	\$6,853.20	\$571.10
Nursing	\$6,040.68	\$503.39

Additionally, if a student takes more than 18.0 credits for an academic term, they are eligible for an additional amount equal to the standard tuition per credit rate for each credit they take over 18.0. The standard rate applies even if the student is eligible for a tuition differential. For example, if a student is majoring in Nursing and is taking 19.0 credits, the maximum they would be eligible for is \$6,478.45 because they are eligible for the full-time rate of \$6,040.68 as well as an additional \$437.77 for the additional credit they took that was greater than 18.0.

Please note that this cap applies only if a student is charged a tuition rate for an academic term at or above the amount listed in the table. If the student is charged a tuition amount below the cap, then they are eligible only for that actual tuition amount charged.
