UW-Stevens Point Transfer Checklist

Application Process:

Spring: No date given

Fall: No date given

- Submit UW System application at <https://apply.wisconsin.edu>
- Submit official high school transcripts or proof of GED (you will also need to submit an official HS transcript from the last high school that you attended)
- If you have taken Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB) or College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) exams, you will need to have your official score report sent to the UWSP Admissions Office so we may review it for possible credit
- Submit official transcripts from each college or university you have attended. If you are currently enrolled in college, request that another official transcript also be sent after all current work is complete.

- If you want to earn your Associate of Arts & Science degree before transferring, please confirm your progress with your Academic Adviser

Admission Criteria

- Priority admission will be given to applicants who have a cumulative GPA of 2.25 or higher.
- Priority admission will be given to transfers from the UW Colleges (2 year campuses) with 54 transferable credits and a 2.00 or higher cumulative GPA
- Transfers with a cumulative GPA of 2.00-2.24 will be considered for admission on an individual basis.
