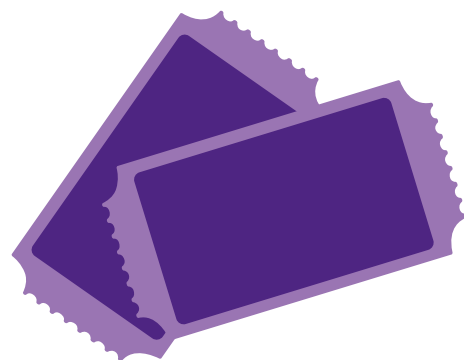

FAQs

English Vouchers

Students enrolled in a participating section of English 101, 102, and 105 receive one voucher for a Young Auditorium performance. Students should check with their professor and refer to the course syllabus to determine if they are enrolled in a section that is eligible for a voucher. Your course fee pays for this voucher and it is added to your HawkCard ID upon registration.



How It Works

The voucher covers admission to one dramatic performance at the Young Auditorium. Your instructor will advise you of the eligible performances. For more information about your eligible performances, please go to www.uww.edu/youngauditorium/season.

FAQs

What is a voucher?

A voucher is a point that is added to your HawkCard ID to be redeemed for a ticket at a Young Auditorium performance. This performance will take place at the Young Auditorium.

How do I use my voucher?

Your English 101, 102, or 105 course fee pays for your ticket to one performance in the Young Auditorium. Upon registration in a participating section of the course, you will receive a voucher on your HawkCard ID. In order to pick up your ticket, please bring your HawkCard ID to Ticket Services in the Greenhill Center of the Arts. They will swipe your card and give you a ticket to the performance you select.

Can I sit by a friend?

Yes. If you would like to sit by someone, please get your tickets in ADVANCE. There are no guarantees on getting seats moved the night of the show. Please come together, or as a group and have all HawkCard IDs ready.

Do I need my ID to pick tickets?

Yes, your English Voucher is stored on your HawkCard ID and we cannot issue a ticket without it.

When should I arrive to the performance?

Proper etiquette when attending a performance or event is to arrive 30-45 minutes prior to the start time. This will prevent congestion at the Ticket Services Box Office and delays starting the show.

What if I lose my ticket?

If you lose your ticket, a Ticket Services manager may be able to reprint your ticket for an event before a performance. Go to Ticket Services in the Greenhill Center of the Arts with your HawkCard ID.

How far in advance can I get my ticket?

All tickets are available now. It is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED that you pick up your TICKETS in ADVANCE as many shows sell out prior to the performance. This will also help prevent congestion at the Box Office before the show!

What if I already used my voucher?

If you have already used your voucher for a specific performance, you can purchase a ticket at the discounted student rate. It is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED that you plan ahead and get your ticket(s) in advance.

Who do I contact if I have questions?

If you have questions about your voucher not being on your HawkCard ID, please go to the HawkCard Office in UC 250.
