Arts4All Program Application

Subsidized Seating

With the Arts4All subsidy program, teachers may apply for a reduction in ticket cost based on their school's percentage of students who qualify for free or reduced lunch. For example, if 50% of the students at your school qualify for free and reduced lunch, then your school may apply for up to a 50% discount on the price of your tickets. Schools must have at least 35% FRL in order to be eligible.

Applications will be reviewed by a panel of educators and staff members. Award assistance will be distributed until all the funds are depleted. Applications must be postmarked by the deadline or received at the Young Auditorium main office by 4:30 p.m. on that date. Applications for both fall and spring semesters will be accepted at that time. Applications received after the deadline will be considered after the on-time applications, pending available funds. Please note that funding is limited.

Subsidized Seat Application

Subsidized seating is available in order to provide opportunities for students to experience the arts by attending a Horizons Matinee Series performance. Please note that we are unable to accept requests for transportation reimbursement at this time.

Guidelines for Application:

- We will begin taking applications May 1 for the upcoming school year. The deadline to submit an application is Sept. 30.
- Teachers will receive a notification email when their application is received in our office.
- Teachers **MUST** have made preliminary reservations prior to submitting this application and **MUST** attach a copy of the confirmation/ invoice they received via email from the Young Auditorium Education Office. Reservations can be made by calling 262-472-4444 or on-line at www.youngauditorium.com
- Schools should please submit one application per performance. **Due to funding restrictions, individual teachers may apply for a subsidy for only one (1) performance.** If multiple teachers or multiple grade levels are coming to the same performance, please use one application for that group. Please discuss the application(s) with your colleagues prior to submission to avoid submitting duplicate applications.
- In order for teachers to apply for assistance, a minimum of 10 students must be attending the performance (excluding teachers and other chaperones).

- Teachers are eligible to apply for a subsidy to help with the cost of student tickets only. Please indicate the number of students who will be attending when completing your application.

The Review Process:

- Applications are blind reviewed by a panel which will include Young Auditorium staff and representatives from local school districts who serve on our Arts Advocacy Committee.
- Teachers will receive notification as to whether or not they received funding by the end of the first week of October. Revised invoices reflecting the new amount due will be issued once funding has been determined.
- Funding is not guaranteed. Funding may be awarded at a level less than the original request. The review committee reserves the right to weigh additional information in their decision making process.
- *If funding is not granted in the amount requested, the applicant will have the option to cancel their preliminary reservation.*
- Funding is limited. All applicants, whether or not they are awarded a subsidy for the performance of their choice, will be placed on a wait list for FREE seats to Horizons shows as they become available during the school year.
